Colorful Abstract Works by Artist Hava Gurevich Provide a Bright Spot at Farmington Hills City Hall

"Organic Fiction," an exhibit of colorful abstract works by contemporary painter Hava Gurevich, helps to counteract the winter gloom by providing a bright spot at Farmington Hills City Hall. Located in the Rotating Exhibits Gallery at 31555 W. Eleven Mile Road, the exhibit runs through March 27 and is open to the public Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Nature serves as inspiration for Gurevich's artwork, which features botanical, aquatic, and microscopic motifs. Eleven new paintings join the two that are part of the Public Art Program now on display at Farmington Hills City Hall.

"I am fascinated by the elegant intricacy and efficiency of patterns that repeat on both small and large scales across a variety of lifeforms, from single-cell amoebas to entire ecosystems," said Gurevich. "Blending images from the real world and imagination, my art celebrates nature in all its beauty, chaos, and complexity."

Gurevich's career in the arts stretches over 25 years as an educator, gallery director, photo curator, and portfolio reviewer. After more than two decades away, she recently moved back to her hometown of Ann Arbor to focus on growing as an artist.

The Public Art Program at Farmington Hills City Hall reflects the goal of the City's Cultural Arts Division to bring art into the daily lives of citizens and employees. Most of the artwork is available for sale and allows local artists to have greater exposure and a bigger client base. The artwork, which is on loan to the City for two years, features the work of 63 talented artists from Farmington Hills and the surrounding areas.
